

- 1. a narrow waterway connecting two larger bodies of water
- 2. a broad and flat or gently rolling area where there are few changes in the landscape
- 3. a stretch of low land lying between hills or mountains and usually having a river or stream flowing through it
- **4.** a long, narrow valley between cliffs, often with a stream flowing through it
- 5. a natural stream of water larger than a creek and emptying into an ocean, lake, or river
- 6. a land area almost entirely surrounded by water
- 7. a deposit of sand and soil formed at the mouth of some rivers
- 8. a landmass, not as large as a continent, surrounded by water
- 9. an inland body of water, usually fresh water, larger than a pool or a pond
- **10.** a group or a chain of islands
