What is a portfolio?

A portfolio is a collection of work representing what a student has learned and accomplished. What goes into the portfolio depends upon the work a student is most proud of and which work best represents the student's learning.

How will the portfolio make a difference in my future?

A portfolio is important because it helps you clarify who you are, what you enjoy, and what you do best. Your portfolio summarizes learning in high school in academic and non-academic settings and determines your next steps. Your portfolio can help you demonstrate your abilities for your future career or college.

Rationale:

This student-focused process allows students to

- Reflect on work and see growth accomplished throughout four years
- Receive positive feedback from staff and community
- Practice the interview process for real-world application
- Focus on strengths
- Begin a life-long process of reflection and service
- Connect work to post-secondary goals

Instructions:

Completed senior portfolio is due May 5, 2014.

Interviews will be May 6-7-8

Because of the size of this assignment, no late portfolios will be accepted.

Portfolios must be complete when turned in. Remember the following:

- Use complete sentences
- Check and double check spelling, punctuation, grammar, usage, etc
- Type in 12 point font and double space. Use fonts that enhance readability
- Do not fold, staple, clip, or mutilate any of the pages
- Final portfolio must be placed in a 3-ring binder
- Portfolio must have chapter dividers, much like your memory books did
