Sean Buchanan Elementary August Board Report:

A. BTS

By the time we have this meeting enrollment will have concluded. We are anxiously looking forward to the new school year. We have a full slate of activities planned to ensure that our back to school season is a success.

B. New Staff

The Elementary will welcome 2 new staff members to our district this year.

C. Learning

Lots of learning has occurred in our school over the past three years! Thank you for your support.

Mr. Buchanan spoke to the Board about the state report card not being an accurate record of how our school was doing. Mr. Buchanan said the system calculates data incorrectly more often than it should. There has been an increase of about 40% in the number of test that have been passed in the Elementary. However, the state said the Academic Achievement and Growth scores have gone down in the Elementary. The State said the Academic Achievement test measures the number of kids who have passed the test. The Academic Growth test measures if they passed it last year, did they pass it this year. Mr. Buchanan stated "How do we prove that learning is occurring"? We use data profiles to measure learning with reading scores on all the assessments, we provide the students. The ACT aspire assessments is a key assessment because it is a line to the actual ACT. By the time students hit 7th grade it will predict their ACT scores if everything stays the same. It will also show for your child's improvement this is the direction you need to take them. This will help the teacher see what direction to go in to help the student. For the students who don't go the college route but want to go the Vocational route the assessments also tie to the Workkeys program. This is also a career readiness program. The curriculum that we provide the teachers comes with its own assessment for each unit of material taught. The state department says we can use those as an indicator for gauging success. These assessments have been a good indicator of who would pass the state assessments. This exact same process will be implemented at the MS and HS to bring the same level of service to all grade levels not just the Elementary.

We will be offering virtual school along with traditional classes. We will be live streaming classes with interaction capabilities. This will be an option for parents who opt not to send their students on site to school.

Mr. Buchanan was impressed that all the teachers were there for training and they were excited to do this.

Mr. Buchanan introduced his new Elementary staff. Ms. Claire Ellison the New 3 year old director at Baby Bison Academy; Ms. Chelsie Pankratz 5th grade math and science; Tammy Bates, New Dean of Students, Gifted and Talented.

Superintendent's Report: OSSBA Annual Conference Aug. 27-30 – Cancelled. There will be virtual training. Start of School-In Service preparing with virtual learning, bonus checks, signing retention paperwork and contracts. Meet the Teacher/Ice Cream Social – Cancelled but are still trying to come up with some virtual ideas. District Repairs and

Updates – Bathrooms, an AC unit we are struggling with, final touches, cleaning and preparing and cleaning the 3 year old head start center to be ready to go.

Mr. Glasgow said we are really going to miss Mary Anne Lawson with her retirement after 46 years in the district. What a great lady. She is welcome to come to the school any time. We will be planning something appropriate when the time is right. That is the least we can do for her many years of dedicated service. Todd said he has been in 5 or 6 schools and she is one in a million and she is all about the kids no matter what, regardless of how they are or how they act good bad or indifferent she just has an unbelievable attitude towards the kids. He is really going to miss her.

New Business: (A) Consideration of any matter not known about or which could not have been reasonably foreseen prior to the posting of the agenda. No new business. However, Todd took the opportunity to inform the board he wanted to hire an extra cleaning person with all the sanitizing we will be doing. We have had few applicants but are still trying to figure out what that positon looks like and what they are going to do. We are still working on that. We have sanitized and will need the extra man power to keep this done. Jason said we had talked about bringing on a new person for this position at the last meeting. He just wanted to be clear that by the end of next week we will bring in that new person.

Board Member Comments. The Board wanted to echo what Todd said about Mary Anne Lawson. They also wanted to thank her for her dedication and support to the school for the past 46 years, she has truly been an asset to the school and will be greatly missed.
