Geary's own, Tom Brack, was a 4x State Finalist and a 1970 State Champion for the Bisons.

After beginning his coaching debut as Duncan Junior High's Head Coach in 1974, he moved on and started Marlow's wrestling program in 1979. After a couple years in Marlow, he began a 12-year stint in Comanche as their Head Coach until 1994 before making his return to where it all started – Duncan. He retired from coaching after 35 years in 2009.

In those 35 years, he was named OWCA Coach of the Year three times, OCA All-State Coach, OCA Regional Coach of the Year and Oklahoma Officials Association Coach of the Year.

As a coach, his teams were 11x state runner-ups 2x state champs 7x regional champs, 15 dual state district champs and a whopping 408 dual winners. He coached 169 state qualifiers with 100 of them placing at state and 27 state champions. Eighteen were honored as OWCA All-Staters and 5 garnered All-Americans

It's because of these accomplishments that he earned his spot in the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame and Duncan Athletic Hall of Fame.

Today, let's welcome Tom Brack into the Geary Invitational Wrestling Tournament Hall of Fame.
